GUIDELINES FOR BUSINESS CASUAL DRESS
Transportation Corporate and Regional offices & shops

Effective August 2016

Statement of Intent

• The Company's Dress Code is intended to provide for a professional, productive and safe work environment. Employees should present themselves in a way that represents the professionalism of the Company, and should dress in a manner that creates a favorable impression, reflects employee pride, and encourages positive morale.



Business casual attire is clean, crisp, and neatly pressed.

Acceptable Crestwood Business Attire



Acceptable Men's Attire

- Slacks, trousers, khakis, chinos or cordurovs*
- CW issued collared, button-down shirts or polo's (long or short-sleeved)
- CW issued sweaters, sweater vests, fleece or wind shirts
- -all must be clean and in good condition



Acceptable Women's Attire

- Slacks, chinos, knee-length or longer skirts or cordurovs *
- CW issued collared, button-down shirts or polo's (long or short-sleeved)
- CW issued sweaters, sweater vests, cardigans, shrugs, fleece or wind shirts
- Dress shoes, boots, loafers or athletic shoes Dress shoes, boots, loafers or athletic shoes all must be clean and in good condition

Jeans are acceptable in field offices daily and in the KC office on Friday's but all jeans must be clean and free of stains, frays, holes or rips of any kind



Clothing to Avoid

Men's Clothing to Avoid

- Cargo pants, sweats, shorts or jeans*
- Any colors other than CW blue, black, white or grey shirts
- Graphic t-shirts, tank tops, sport team tshirts or jackets, sweatshirts
- Slippers, house shoes, casual sandals such as flip-flops or slide-ons.
- Chains, lanyards or any other item hanging from belt-loop or pocket

Women's Clothing to Avoid

- Spandex pants, yoga pants, cargo pants, sweats, shorts or jeans*
- Mini skirts, short skirts or "skorts"
- Strapless dresses or tops
- Graphic t-shirts, low-cut blouses, tank tops, camisoles, spaghetti-strap tops or midriff tops
- Slippers, house shoes or flip-flops
- Chains, lanyards or any other item hanging from belt-loop or pocket

*Jeans may be worn on Fridays, as long as they are neat and in the spirit of a professional business environment. Jeans should not be cut-off or frayed, low-rise, or have rips or holes or stains.
